In follow up of the Regional District of Nanaimo's previous notice of August 20, 2018, please be reminded that pile driving activities are scheduled to take place from October 22 to November 9, 2018. These activities will take place during regular City of Nanaimo noise bylaw hours.

Pile driving is required to stabilize the ground underneath two new tanks, and uses a large diesel-hammer to hammer a steel pipe into the ground. The activity generates a banging noise.
