RE: Notification of Work – FortisBC Pipeline Maintenance, Horne Lake Road

To ensure the continued safe and reliable delivery of natural gas service in the region, FortisBC will be working to replace a section of natural gas pipeline at the intersection of Horne Lake Road and Thorpe Road. Work is scheduled to commence July 25 and to be completed on July 29, 2016.

This project is part of standard system maintenance/upgrade. The existing pipe has been in continuous service since it was first installed in 1991. The upgrade will meet growing customer demand and extend the pipeline's service life. FortisBC does not anticipate any service disruption to customers as a result of construction.

FortisBC is working to minimize interruptions and complete the work as safely and quickly as possible. Vehicle traffic on Horne Lake Road should expect delays and may be reduced to single lane traffic during construction.

There will be a full closure of Horne Lake Road (from Thorpe Rd to Olympic Rd) between approximately 7 p.m. July 27 and 7 a.m. July 28. Crews will work to minimize the impact of light and noise during work conducted in the evening and overnight.

FortisBC asks that road users be aware of construction activity and follow the instructions of flaggers.
