Questions and Answers:

- Q1) Does the secondary treatment project at GNPCC include consideration of the space required to place the empty bin while removing the filled bin?
- A1) Yes, there will be space allocated in the secondary treatment project for placement of the empty bin while removing the filled bin.
- Q2) What is the maintenance schedule for the unpaved access roads?
- A2) Roads used by the Transporter are graded once per year in the summer by SYLVIS. Throughout the contract, the Transporter will identify specific maintenance issues to SYLVIS who will endeavour to repair these issues with their on-site equipment.
- Q3) We would like to request that the RDN update <u>Appendix B -Quotation Form</u> so separate rates could be provided for delivery to each individual Stockpile.
- A3) The RDN considered this request but decided against updating the Quotation Form due to the additional administration for the successful Proponent associated with setting up separate rates by Stockpile. The RDN would prefer to remain with the existing rate structure.
